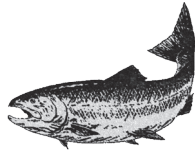
LAUNCH RAMPS AND SERVICES

Five launch ramps within Derby boundaries have fish weigh stations. (Other launch options are also available.) West-to-east, official ramps are:

- **Freshwater Bay Boat Ramp** – in Freshwater Bay Park near Joyce, off Route 112. (Turn north from 112 onto Freshwater Bay Road approximately 4.5 miles after leaving Route 101.)
- **Ediz Hook Boat Ramp** – in Port Angeles at the end of the spit, near Coat Guard Station; access via Marine Drive at west end of spit (by the mill). All Port Angeles Harbor marine resources are nearby.
- **Gardiner Boat Ramp** – on Discovery Bay in lovely Gardiner. (Off Highway 101 – follow Gardiner Beach Road north to the water.) Food and supplies are ten minutes down Route 101 in each direction.
- **John Wayne Marina** – at 2577 W. Sequim Bay Rd., on Sequim Bay, 360-417-3440; Ron Amundson, Harbormaster. Offers launch, fuel, and overnight moorage, with two launch lanes. Staff always work hard for Derby participants. No repair service, but many area vendors are nearby (see “Shopping”).
- **Port of Port Townsend** – at Port Townsend Boat Haven, 2601 Washington St. (off Sims Way), 360-385-2355. Offers launch, fuel, and overnight moorage. Marine and repair services are nearby, along with many area vendors (see “Shopping”).

LAUNCH FEES

Launch fees vary. The Gardiner boat ramp is free. This year's decisions haven't been made yet, but in most years: Ediz Hook and Freshwater Bay are free; the Port of Port Townsend waives its fees; and John Wayne Marina is either free or offers a discounted rate. Check Derby website for current details.

Many stores and restaurants are located in **Port Townsend, Sequim, Port Angeles**, and in between.

Most Sequim hotels are about 10 minutes west of John Wayne Marina. Gardiner is between Sequim and Port Townsend (15-25 minutes from each). Port Angeles is 20 miles west of Sequim.

SAFETY, WEATHER, TIDES

- **On-the-water emergency:** Contact any neighboring boats; or call **Vessel Assist** via **VHF Channel 16** (or at **1-800-367-8222**). For non-emergencies, use **VHF Channel 68**.
- **Safety equipment:** Remember to **carry all Coast Guard required equipment**. Fishing derbies are patrolled, and you might get checked on the water.
- **Weather information:** Use VHF weather channel 3 or 4. February has **unpredictable weather**. The Derby website has links to Internet weather sites.
- **Tides:** Tide charts are available at local stores. Be sure you are familiar with local tides and currents!
